## Wide Horizons Background



Wide Horizons Community Development Program was established in 2006 by World Education (WE) and Burma Migrant Worker's Education Committee (BMWEC), in Mae Sot Tak, Thailand.

Wide Horizons is a two-year leadership development program dedicated to building the capacity of young adults from Burma to work effectively in civil society organization.

Wide Horizons program selects 24 students every year who have at least one year work experience in their host organization. They come from different ethnicities and religions around Thai- Burma border and inside Burma. The ages are between 20 to 35 years old. They come from different organizations. The school provides three main subjects such as English, Community Development and Computer skills. After the academic year, they will be able to help effectively at their host organization to improve education sections and development sections.

For example, in education boys and girls are getting the same marks but when they apply for a job or further study, boys have more opportunities. So, women have to get higher level of education in order to get the same opportunities as men.

## Learning by Doing

Wide Horizons School trains students how to communicate with people in their community and how to collect community information. We are doing four projects in communities in this year. The projects are at Minmahaw School, New Wave Migrant Learning Center, SAW Safe House and New Blood school. The students at the Wide Horizons School divided into four groups to work on their projects.

We have learnt many skills such as project management, proposal writing, and collecting information from the community. We are researching problems, which need to be solved urgently. Moreover, we gain understanding of the migrant students and how many challenges they are facing. We have six students for each project groups. For our group, we take responsibility to help students at New Blood school.

New Blood School is a school which accepts migrant students who are living in Mae Sot area and inside Burma. It is located at Nang Bwer village in Mae Sot, Thai-Burma border. The school was established in October 2003 by U Zaw Lwin Oo who is currently director at New Blood school.

The school mission is to improve migrant children ideas and education who are underprivileged to study in high school. There are 691 students (372 males and 319 females) in the school. The age of between 3-25 years old are living in there. They are different ethnic groups such as Kachin, Karen, Chin, Burma, Mon and Shan. There are 35 students that have been orphaned and abandoned. Additionally, there are 45 students from broken families and six students are disability.

According to our prioritizing problem, New Blood School needs new good quality bed for their boarding house students. Now our proposal is almost finished and will be sent to the potential donor soon.

We are very lucky to have a chance to study very useful skills at Wide Horizons and we have chance to practice our skills by helping those students in the community.

## Interview with Alumni



Ka Na Dee (Former Student)

Ka Na Dee is 25 years old and he graduated from Wide Horizon School in 2015. He comes from Te Cha Ra village, Myawaddy Township in Kayin state. At the moment, he is working at Mae Tao Clinic, Mae Sot in Thailand. We interviewed with him about how his life has been changed after attending at Wide Horizon School. Therefore, we would like to share with you what he has told us.

### **Stella: What is your responsibility?**

**Ka Na Dee:** My responsibility is I have to write monthly report to our donor. Also, I have responsible for checking activities such as malaria medicine, mosquito net and health project every month. I have to ask to Shoklo Malaria Research Unit (SMRU) before those are running out. If I got these medicine and mosquito net, I need to distribute to the departments. After it, I have to report to donor every month.

Also, I have to do relevance fundraising for sale shirts. Moreover, I have to distribute mosquito net and medicine boxes to the departments when a person who anonymous donors come and donate. If we have to report for once a year, I have to collect and ask case story about what kinds of diseases happening in the clinic that we had faced.

### **Stella: Why did you apply this school?**

**Ka Na Dee:** I applied Wide Horizons School to gain more skills and to be capable to work effectively in our community such as communication with donors, to be able to speak English confidently. Wide Horizon is one of the program that trains young people who work in Migrant Community and inside Myanmar to work effectively in their communities. So, I was really interested in it and I applied this school.

### **Stella: Why do you think those skills are important to you?**

**Ka Na Dee:** When we come back to our organization to improve our community, we have to do projects as well. So, if we do not know how to manage or plan the projects, it will not be successful. Writing proposal is important to get supporting from our donors. Therefore, we have to write proposal and send to them. Furthermore, English speaking is international language, so it helps us to be able to communicate with time. After I practice again and again, I can do very many different people in the world. We can exchange knowledge and experience with them.



## Interview with Alumni

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**Stella: How is different after and before you attend Wide Horizons?**

**Ka Na Dee:** Before I attended Wide Horizons, I worked as a Health worker in Mae Tao Clinic. Sometimes, I have to interpret between foreigner and patients. When the foreigner asked me questions, I did not understand and could not reply immediately. So, it was difficult to interpret and it became a big challenge between patients and foreigners. At that time, I also did not have self-confidence to speak with foreigners to understand as well.

After I graduated from Wide Horizons, it was much easier than before. I understood what foreigners say and I could interpret for the patients easily. I was confident to discuss or to communicate with them, so I didn't need to worry any more to interpret between foreigners and patients.

**Stella: Do you like Wide Horizons program? And why?**

**Ka Na Dee:** I like WH school because Wide Horizons is a very helpful program that has changed my life much better.

**Stella: What is your future plan?**

**Ka Na Dee:** I have 2 plans for my future. The first plan is after I work for 3 years at Mae Tao Clinic, I want to move in Myanmar and work with NGO such as community development for giving training in the village. Second plan is if I still stay here, I am going to apply ACU (Australia Catholic University).

**Stella: How do you apply the skills those you gained from Wide Horizon at your Organization?**

**Ka Na Dee:** When I finished Wide Horizons school, I came back to work at my organization, my responsibility is changed. I have to work in the management department. Mostly, I have to use computer skills that I have learned from Wide Horizons such as Microsoft Excel and Microsoft word. Also, English speaking like before I interpret for foreigners and patients.

**Stella: What is your challenge for working at Organization now?**

**Ka Na Dee:** When I started to come back for working, I faced challenge of practical. When we learnt at WH, we only learnt theory. When we come back to work placement, we have to do logically. Sometimes we plan for our projects to finish during two months, but we have not finished yet. So, I had challenges for the first well.

## Retain Karen Traditional Clothes

Wearing traditional clothes are significant things for every ethnic minority group. Every culture has their own traditional clothing. Karen people also have their own culture clothes. So, to maintain our traditional clothes, Karen people should wear our traditional clothes. Not only the Karen who lives in Karen area but also who lives different places as well.

First of all, I would like to share how we make our traditional clothes and how we wear it. Before we turn fabric into clothing, we use cotton and make it into thread. Then, we use the thread to weave our clothes. Moreover, Karen clothing has meaning. All Karen people do not wear the same clothing because, they have a connection to age. For the girls, when they are young and have not already married, they usually wear a long dress. After they marry, they have to wear short shirt with a skirt that was wrapped around at their waist called longyi.

In the past, ancient Karen people had to follow this cultural tradition in their own culture. If they do not obey this tradition, they will face a big problem with the community. For example, there is a legend that a tiger will bite and take them away. Therefore, most of the Karen people strongly believe and try to follow ancient people oral tradition. However, many people forget about their own traditional clothing. The Karen traditional clothing is not the same with the past traditional anymore, because some people wear them incorrectly or in an inappropriate way. Now, Karen people are not loyal to their ancestors by wearing Karen clothing. Moreover, some people do what they want because they forget their tradition and the teaching of their ancestors.

Nowadays, many people are making new designs of Karen clothes that respect the traditions for modern Karen girls. Since some people have been separated from Burma, they do not wear their traditional clothing often. They wear more simple clothes as if other cultures do. They don't wear their traditional clothes very often, because they live in other countries and they copied other culture traditional clothes. Moreover, they don't have their own country, so some children don't know how to wear and how to respect their traditional clothes. If we wear Karen clothes, other ethnic also will know about our culture and they will recognize that we are united ethnic group.

I want to convince Karen people to maintain the traditions of wearing traditional clothes by contributing this newsletter, as well as to encourage them to be proud of wearing Karen traditional clothes and to show out around the world.

## Sequa and Jackie at Wide Horizons

Luckily, he is friends with the Wide Horizons teachers and gave Jackie to the school. The first time, Jackie was afraid of everyone and avoided Sequa.

However, over time, he has become friends with Sequa and every students also loves him.

You might think that dogs are very scary and you don't like them. But, actually dogs are very friendly and can be great security for your house. Since the Wide Horizon was founded, I have never heard thieves robbed in WH. Therefore, I believe that it is because we have the dogs. Our dogs bark is so vicious.

Furthermore, Sequa and Jackie are excited and protective when the strangers come to our school compound, especially at night time, Sequa and Jackie are the best security guards for WH female students. Those two dogs always sleep in front of WH girls' dormitory door. When the strangers come in front of girls' dormitory, they bark to the strangers. When they bark, we directly know that strangers come to our school. So that we go and check. Sequa is the super dog for my life, because it has protected me from other dangerous dogs. He also protects other WH students in many different situations.

At that time, I felt disappointed because I did not like any dogs.
